Includes the vehicle plant in Zwickau, the engine plant in Chemnitz and the Gläserne Manufaktur in Dresden. It is now possible to visit the Zwickau site for 90 minutes.

Why a visit to the Zwickau plant? With the e-offensive, Volkswagen has initiated the largest and most fundamental transformation in its corporate history. At the Zwickau plant, series production of the fully electric ID.3. started in 2019. It is the first model of a brand new e-car family. A total of six electric vehicles are produced at the Zwickau plant, including the ID.4, the Audi Q4 e-tron and the Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron as well as the Cupra Born.

Volkswagen aims to sell around 26 million e-cars across the Group by 2029 and drive forward the transport revolution. The plant in Saxony plays a key role here: For the first time in the world, a large car plant has been completely converted to electric mobility. This involved completely rebuilding the production lines, training all 8,000 employees for e-mobility and converting the energy supply to green electricity.

The site becomes the largest electric car plant in Europe and assumes a pioneering role in Volkswagen's transformation to the electric age.
